Perforated or “punch” plate provides a more accurate and stronger screening surface than conventional wire cloth. Perforated plate is available in square, round, hexagonal and slotted openings to provide you with a variety of options. Openings can be *Staggered* or *Straight-lined* to meet your specific application needs.

This product offers excellent impact resistance and good wear resistance. You may select square, round, hexagonal or slotted perforations. Hardness ranges from 85-B, AR-235, AR-400 and AR-500.

Rubber-clad perforated plate

Rubber provides superior impact resistance and greater wear life Vs. standard perforated plate. Ideally suited for scalping applications, a rubber surface is molded to a full steel backing plate to provide superior wear life. This product can be manufactured in rubber compounds suited for dry or wet applications and it is good for both crushed and natural products. Standard openings range from 1" to 10" with rubber thicknesses available up to 5" and a steel backing thickness from 1/4" to 1/2". Rubber and steel backing thicknesses are determined by size and weight of material.
